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Hi sweet pea -

Got this text from Humphrey last night - it sounds like a case of crossed wires as Humphrey would never go ahead with a sale that he wasn't given the go-ahead for. It is not in his best interest to be underhand at all, he is very professional and shafting a client is no way to get repeat business.
