Per Your questions from yesterday:

1. Is the truck usable?

The truck is able to drive but the windows and a/c currently doesn't work. They recently installed a new turbo for this vehicle as well.

2. Current Value of this vehicle?

Based on Kelly blue book value of truck in conditions as is the truck is worth approximately \$13,000

3. Why Did you call a Florida Dealer?

I spoke to the Bob who works for AL Packer Ford Lincoln which is a Ford dealer ship located in West Palm Beach. Per my discussion with Bob there company can quote all parts except the **Fully Assembled Bed and Lift Gate**. They can sell the piece for the Bed but we will have to assembled the Bed of the truck ourselves. In regard to the Lift Gate I was told by vendor that they currently do not sell this item. I have attached the invoice for you to review.

Al Packer Inv. # Q252653_ **\$1,030.29**. Based on the items that they are able to quote us versus the prices from National Parts and Caribbean Motoring for same parts. Caribbean Motoring price will be substantially lower than both vendors.

Greetings Rich,

Here is a new order for Parts for the 2008 Ford F250 Super Duty. This order is a variation of upgrades to the vehicle as well as replacement of broken parts. The broke items on the vehicle is the outside mirrors(Both left and right side), Right Rear brake Caliper (Out of stock on STT), Window Regulator (Both left and right side), Window Crank Handles (Both left and right side), Bed and Inside/Outside Door Handles (Both left and Right side). The upgrades to the vehicle is the Tommy Lift Gate. I have attached pictures of the truck for you to review.

The breakdown new order of 2008 Ford 250 Super Duty are as followed:

A.

I received two quotes for 2008 Ford F250 Parts from the companies National Parts as well as Caribbean Motoring here are the details as followed:

PLEASE NOTE ALL SHIPPING CHARGES ARE ESTIMATES.

Caribbean Motoring **Estimate# 1003 \$8,917.64 (Shipping Charges are estimated \$1,600.00 but it may vary).** The original price for items shown on the invoice is **\$7,217.64.** I have attached the invoice for you to review.

Per conversation with vendor the items is available withing **1 week.**

National Parts **Quote \$ 9,296.34(Shipping charges are estimated \$2,750.00 based on conversation with vendor but it may vary).** The original price shown on the invoice is **\$6,546.34.** I have attached the invoice for you to review.

The items will be available within **3 weeks.**

B.

Caribbean Motoring ETA for parts are as followed:**Bed -ETA 2 business days** to Caribbean Motoring, **Lift gate- ERA 5-7 business days** to Caribbean Motoring and **Other Parts - ETA 3-5 business days** or less to Caribbean Motoring

National Parts. ETA for parts are as followed:**Bed - ETA 2-3 weeks out** to National Parts ATL store, **Lift gate- ETA 2-3 weeks out** to National Parts ATL store and **Other Parts - 1 business day** to National Parts

C.

Caribbean Motoring. Caribbean Motoring will be able to send the items to through Tropical Shipping located in Fort Lauderdale, FL. I take about a week for the items to reach STT.

National Parts. National Parts can send the smaller items through the DHL to arrive on STT the next day once ordered. (**Estimated shipping charges per items are \$100-\$125**). The **Lift Gate** and **Bed** will come through Tropical Shipping in Atlanta which takes 1 week to arrive to **STT (Estimated shipping charges \$1,250.00 price may vary)**.

D.

Caribbean motoring. Takes **1 week** to arrive to his store. So if ordered today they will receive it on Tuesday 03/07/17 from there to Tropical Shipping in Florida set to arrive on either Monday 03/13/17 or Wednesday 03.15/17 to STT. **Please note that all shipping charges are estimates. Vendor suggest to pay the shipping fees once items are receive by him and not before hand.**

National Parts. Takes **4 weeks** to receive the complete order of parts to National Parts in Atlanta. I give two suggestion on for time frames to reach STT:

Shipping charges are deemed once the items have been weighed in the store.

Suggestion 1: It will take **1 business day** for the **caliper, mirror, window regulator, and handles** to reach to his store and items will arrive on STT the 03/02/17. The **Lift gate and Bed** will take roughly **2-3 weeks** to arrive to National Parts in Atlanta. After it arrives based on the size of the items they will travel by boat using Tropical Shipping in Atlanta and the estimated arrival **1 week** from the day it was shipped.

Suggestion 2: If we wait to ship all items at once it will take roughly **3 weeks** for the items to be received by National parts in Atlanta. When all items are received it will travel through Tropical Shipping in Atlanta it take about a **1 week** from the day it was shipped.

E.

Caribbean Motoring. For the purchase you can use either a credit card or wire transfer. **Wire Transfer instruction are attached to the bottom of the invoice. PLEASE NOTE ALL SHIPPING CHARGES ARE ESTIMATES.** Vendor suggest to pay the shipping fees once items are receive by him not beforehand.

National Parts. For this purchase you can use either a credit card or wire transfer. The wire transfer instructions are attached.**PLEASE NOTE ALL SHIPPING CHARGES ARE ESTIMATES.**

F.

Caribbean Motoring. Per conversation with vendor he will only budge on the price for the lift gate. He quoted us on a **aluminum lift gate** which which has the best protection from corrosion from the salt air. The next option was to quote us on a **steel lift gate** which drops the price by **\$3,300.00** but this material can be corroded easily in the salt air which can be more costly in the future.

National Parts . based on conversation with the vendor the price shown on invoice is lowest he will go on the price so he can receive a profit on this order.

Recommendations

My recommendations is go with **Caribbean Motoring** based on the time frame for the parts to reach to STT.
