[REDACTED] closet design is below. Is the change correct – I took out the shelves and short hang and converted it to long. The new cost for his closet with this change is \$3494. The material we use is a thermo fused melamine laminate.

For your closet, the only changes we made was eliminating the bottom shelf/toe kick and bringing the partitions off the floor in the shoe closet and the long hanging sections. Everything else will be floor based.
